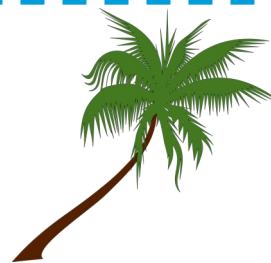

fun indoors, with beach themed decor and classic picnic food. Wear your favorite Hawaiian shirt and sun hat and say "Aloha" to old man winter!

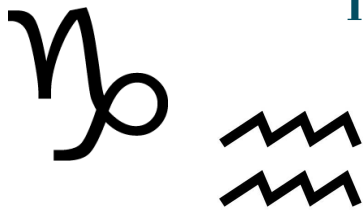
More Music in the Courtyard

Orange Christmas Rusks
