Landscaping Plans Finally Emerge

After undergoing a new generator, underground utility work, and tree removal, the land between the back deck and the Town Green will experience a facelift come late Summer! Plans will include a 14 by 24 foot storage shed, expanded views of the Town



Green, perennials, a cutting garden, walk-ways, sitting areas, and ornamental trees. "Combining the need for increased storage, the shed sort of lead the di-

rection and the rest just fell into place," said Bethany Brenner, Executive Director.

A land survey and professional design work will begin soon. Woodcrest anticipates the final project to be completed by late August or early September. Watch for updates and design plans in the upcoming weeks!
