Recipe of the Month:

Watermelon Mint Granita

This refreshing treat is a snap to make and really satisfies on a hot summer day!

First, make a simple syrup by boiling 1 cup of sugar with 1 cup of water, add a handful of mint leaves as it cools and then strain. Next, remove the flesh of 1 large watermelon, deseed, and puree until smooth, add the simple syrup to taste. Puree mixture into a shallow pan and freeze solid. Using a fork, scrape the flavored ice up and scoop into dishes and enjoy on a sunny patio!
